We see the effects of devastation every day. Sometimes, we live them. Beginning in February and spanning 2018's entirety, Indonesians endured nature's unbelievable wrath, landslides, earthquakes,

tsunamis, tornadoes, and volcanic eruption testing their will. Month after month, more homes, businesses, schools, and places of worship and play were obliterated.

In their place lay mud, rubble, snapped power lines, impassable roads. Another constant in the

year of endless devastation? Questionable hope for the future – for those who survived.

Shaken to their core, yet determined to serve, Lions mobilized. With nearly US\$240,000 in Disaster grant funding from Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCF), Lions delivered food, water, clothing, and medicine, meeting basic human needs for survival.

"First, we tended to immediate needs. People must eat, have clean water, and their medicines," said one Lion serving her fellow Indonesians. "But we are Lions. We continue delivering hope by remaining well after a catastrophe to rebuild and heal." Indeed, with LCIF grant funds, Lions reconstructed four severely damaged schools and restored daily life for thousands in nearby communities.
